

Waco-Midway FFA Alumni Association Scholarship 2022 Application & Instructions

Please be sure to read all instructions and requirements before beginning the application.

Waco Midway FFA Alumni Association Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a 2022 graduating senior of Midway High School.
- Eligible applicants must have parents/guardians that maintain Waco-Midway FFA Alumni Association paid membership for the applicants Junior **and** Senior academic years and maintain more than 50% meeting attendance.
- A completed application must be mailed to Waco-Midway FFA Alumni Association, PO Box 21451, Waco, Texas 76702. All completed applications must be postmarked no later than **Monday, March 21, 2022**.
- Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better (including multiplier) through the first semester of their senior year.
- Applicant must provide high school transcript for verification
- All applications must be submitted with a 4x6 size photo.
- Recommendation forms from a Teacher/Faculty member must be completed and accompany the application by due date. It is the student's responsibility to furnish forms to faculty members and mail the completed forms with their application.
- Awards may be used for the purpose of tuition, room/board, books and mandatory fees at any university, college, business or vocational school approved by its state-accrediting agency.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified in May. Scholarship payments will be paid in full directly to the school the recipient attends in the Fall 2022 semester. Awards not accepted in the Fall 2022 semester will be forfeited.
- Only typed applications will be accepted.
- Incomplete applications or applications postmarked later than Monday, March 21, 2022 will not be considered.

HOW ARE SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED?

Three outside judges will be selected to score all applications. An average of the three scores will be the applicant's final score and determine student's eligibility to receive a scholarship.

The total amount awarded for 2022 scholarships was predetermined by the Midway FFA Alumni Executive Board. Scholarship recipients and individual scholarship amounts will be selected based on top scores. Not all applicants are guaranteed scholarship money.

Scholarship recipients will be notified via provided email. It will be the responsibility of the student to provide the Treasurer of the Waco-Midway FFA Alumni Association with a copy of student schedule, UIN# from the attending school, and student ID # for the 2022 Fall semester. These documents must be submitted to the Waco-Midway FFA Alumni Association, PO Box 21451, Waco, Texas 76702 by deadline in the notification email. Upon receipt of required documents, the scholarship will be awarded. Payments will only be made to schools within the United States.

Payment of the scholarship will be made in full directly to the attending school.
Awards not accepted in the 2022 Fall semester will be forfeited.

Final Check List:

- Read carefully and complete all sections of the application.
- Proofread application before turning it in.
- Completed applications include the application, transcript, individual 4x6 photo, and teacher/faculty recommendation forms.
- Completed applications must be mailed to Waco-Midway FFA Alumni Association, PO Box 21451, Waco, Texas 76702. All completed applications must be postmarked no later than **Monday, March 21, 2022.**
