2023 State Convention Attendance Application

The 2023 Texas FFA State Convention will be held in Dallas, TX. This is the culmination of the year's successes for all 1100+ Agricultural Science programs statewide. Chapters from all around the state come to a designated location to celebrate, receive awards, compete, and learn. It is a rewarding experience for any student to attend and numbers are limited for attendance.

Any student that is receiving an award or is competing at the state FFA convention will receive priority in any given year. If there are any spots still available, preference will be given to those that have earned their right to attend by attending meetings, participating in activities, fundraising, district and area meetings, etc.

Those selected to attend will be required to pay a \$250 fee (officers only need to pay \$150 due to officer camp fee). This will include convention registration, parking, housing, two lunches, three dinners, and all breakfasts, and transportation. The convention registration fee allows each student to attend every session and concert.

A completed application is due no later than Monday 5/16 at 4pm and the \$250 fee, if selected, will be due no later than Monday 5/23 at 4pm. Any student that does not pay the fee will be dropped and the next available student will be awarded the right to attend. If any student decides that not to attend convention, they will forfeit that \$250 as we will have already entered that student.

Each member must have COMPLETE official dress to attend. That includes the FFA jacket, scarf/tie, black pants/knee-length skirt, black closed toed shoes, and white collared shirt. *The FFA will not be lending this paraphernalia for the FFA Convention*. All items can be purchased from the FFA website (www.ffa.org). Any student not in compliance will not be attending.
