

Midway FFA Livestock Eligibility Checklist (for exhibitors at Ag Facility)

Student exhibited their project at the McLennan County Junior Livestock Show <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The student's project made the minimum weight requirement for their species and was exhibited at MCJLS Student is expected to sell their project if a sale spot is earned <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Exceptions include multiple sale spots earned according to MCJLS rules, exhibiting that project at a major livestock show, previous agreements with Ag Science teacher and breeder for breeding animals, etc. 		
Student attended one of the Livestock Information meetings on _____ or _____ <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Barn returners <u>ONLY</u> can receive a check for attending the first species meeting 		
Students are expected to maintain excellent behavior during school and represent Midway FFA to the highest degree. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If a student receives ISS for five or more days during the school year, they will receive a "no" (partial days spent in ISS will be considered a day) If a student is placed in DAEP, they will receive a "no" 		
Student's AET record book approved by Ag teacher at final checkpoint. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> SAE Plan- description, time investment, financial investment, and learning objectives (suggested outlines on AET should be followed) Finances- receipts entered correctly spanning the entire feeding period <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o What should be included for most exhibitors: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Purchase Price Validation Fee Entry Fees for Shows Feed and Supply Purchases Vet Bills (if applicable) Sale Price Journal entries- minimum of 10 journal entries documenting animal's progress. Entries should include weights, health, feed, changes, etc. 		

Students receiving three or more "NOs" on the checklist will not be permitted to exhibit a livestock project through Midway FFA the following year. Students receiving two or fewer "NOs" will be eligible to exhibit a project at MCJLS the following year. Students receiving one or fewer "NOs" will be eligible to exhibit a project at the major level the following year.

****In addition to the Livestock Eligibility checklist, according to the Ag Facility rules and contract: A written strike system will be implemented. If students and parents do not comply with the rules listed in this document (i.e. completing barn duty/cleaning schedule), upon receiving their third written ASIF strike, the student will have to remove their animal within 24 hours.**
